

FAQs 2022 GFFA

General questions:

- When will the 2022 GFFA take place?
 - o The event will take place in a digital form from 24 to 28 January 2022.
- At what time will the 2022 GFFA take place?
 - o The event will take place from 08:00 a.m. to 06:30 p.m. CET (Central European Time).
- Where can I obtain current information on the event?
 - o Please register so we can keep you up to date: <https://www.gffa-berlin.de/en/service/keep-me-informed/>
- Will the 2022 GFFA be completely virtual, or will individual programme segments take place on location?
 - o The event will mostly be a virtual event. The kick-off, first day of the GFFA will also take place in Berlin.
- What technical requirements must I meet to participate in the 2022 GFFA?
 - o You will need a computer or smartphone with a speaker, an Internet browser and a stable Internet connection. If you wish to actively participate in the programme, you will also need a microphone and a camera.
- Can I also take part via telephone?
 - o Yes. However, you will not be able to actively participate in the programme and you will not be able to see presentations, whiteboards or videos. We therefore recommend participation via a digital device.

Participation/registration:

- Who can attend the 2022 GFFA virtually?
 - o Anyone interested can attend the event. However, no invitations or participation certificates will be issued.
- What is the fee for attending?
 - o Participation is free of charge.
- How can I attend/register?

Programme:

- What will be on the programme?
 - o The various event segments of the 2022 GFFA will be distributed over the entire week (Monday–Friday). This means that interested participants can attend all public event segments. The entire programme is available here: <https://www.gffa-berlin.de/en/fachveranstaltungen/>
- Will there be an official launch of the 2022 GFFA?
 - o The event will be launched during a hybrid kick-off event on 24 January 2022.
- Will there be High Level Panels and Expert Panel discussions again?
 - o There will be two High Level Panels and several Expert Panel discussions. Their distribution over the entire week means that there will be no parallel events. Interested participants can thus attend all public events this year.
- Will there be another innovation market this year?
 - o Yes, there will be an innovation market at the 2022 GFFA. It will also take place virtually for the first time.
- Will there be another Think Aloud! – GFFA Science Slam?
 - o Yes, the 2022 GFFA will also feature a science slam. It will take place as a hybrid event.

- What is the Berlin Agriculture Ministers' Conference?
 - o The Berlin Agriculture Ministers' Conference is the political highlight of the GFFA. It is the largest meeting of agriculture ministers in the world and has established itself as an important international key event at the beginning of each year. Its final communiqué is a call for action and is fed into the ongoing international discourse on agricultural policy.
- Can I attend the Berlin Agriculture Ministers' Conference?
 - o Viewers will be able to attend the kick-off event of the virtual Berlin Agriculture Ministers' Conference via a live stream.
- What is the Young Farmers' Forum?
 - o Every year, young farmers from all around the world meet at the GFFA and lay the foundation for the broad exchange of experience and knowledge between young farmers from all continents. They have an in-depth exchange about their experiences and draw up their own declaration on the year's GFFA subject, which includes their demands with respect to agricultural policy. Please note: this event is exclusive to the young farmers invited. It is not a public event.
- Will there be another partnering event?
 - o After a lot of positive feedback from the 2020 and 2021 GFFA, the coming event will again feature an opportunity for networking and discussion among the participants. You will receive information on how to register and use the tool once registration opens at the end of the year.
